The Teacher position works closely with other team members to facilitate and nurture children's physical, social-emotional, cognitive, and language development; establishes and maintains a positive children-oriented environment; participates in planning and program training; works with families in child development activities, parent involvement, and accessing community resources; and collaborates with community partners. **To qualify for Level 1, you must have:** an Associates degree in Early Childhood Education or a related field (Education, Human Development, Family and Consumer Studies, Child and Family Studies, Psychology, Sociology, Social Work) with a minimum of 6 classes in Child Development or Early Childhood Education. **To qualify for Level 2, you must have:** a Bachelor's degree in Early Childhood Education or a related field (Education, Human Development, Family and Consumer Studies, Child and Family Studies, Psychology, Sociology, Social Work) with a minimum of 6 classes in Child Development or Early Childhood Education. **Both positions require:** High school diploma or General Education Degree (GED); minimum of two years experience in early childhood programs; the ability to register with the Criminal History Registry of the Child Care Division; a Valid Oregon Driver's License with an acceptable driving record; insured vehicle available for use on the job or acceptable alternative; and good communication skills with the ability to follow verbal and written instructions. **Bilingual positions require:** demonstrated abilities to read, write, and speak fluently in Spanish and English.
